The Exporter certifies that it will provide SEA SHIPPING LINE with complete, correct, and accurate information, based on personal
knowledge of the facts stated, and all necessary and proper documentation required to permit SEA SHIPPING LINE to accurately
file the EEI on the AES. Exporter further understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent
statements or for the violation of any United States laws or regulations on exportation and Exporter agrees to be bound by all
statements of SEA SHIPPING LINE based upon the information or documentation provided by Exporter to SEA SHIPPING LINE.

Exporter also agrees to indemnify SEA SHIPPING LINE and hold it harmless from and against any, and all, liability or damage SEA
SHIPPING LINE may suffer as a result of Exporter providing incomplete, false or inaccurate information to SEA SHIPPING LINE.
This Power of Attorney is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given by the Exporter to, and received
by, SEA SHIPPING LINE.
