Dear valued customer,

On August 19, 2014, Bureau Veritas appointed by the Ghana Standard Authority (GSA) to implement a Conformity Assessment Program – known as "G-CAP" and known in other countries as PVOC or PCA.

Therefore, beginning 10/1/14 all shipments destined to Ghana will be subject to the Verification of Conformity to National or International standards in the region of export.

The categories of subjected products are the following :

- Toys and Sports
- Electronic and Electrical products
- Automotive (including new and used vehicles)
- Chemical products
- Mechanical materials and gas appliances
- Paper and Stationery
- Furniture (wood and metal articles)
- Safety (personal protective equipment)
- Food and Food products
- Construction Materials
- Selected medical devices and pharmaceuticals
- Used products
- Fuel/Petroleum products
- Textile and footwear

Shippers that wish to export cargo to Ghana will need to schedule an inspection and request a Certificate from the Bureau Veritas local contact.
